The rental fee is \$5.00, plus postage.

CDs and DVDs are sent via "First Class" postage, usually \$2.07 each way

Slides must be mailed via "Priority Mail," usually \$4.90 each way

Binder must be mailed via "Priority Mail," usually \$4.90 each way

GUIDELINES WHEN ORDERING –

Please contact Mary Craft by email (mary@thimblecraft.com), by phone (903-887-6768), or U.S. mail (P.O. Box 1934, Mabank, TX 75147) to request the program of your choice. The person renting the program and taking responsibility for it must be a TCI member. Your current mailing address is required for shipping the program.

Please be sure to state the exact date of your meeting, if applicable, and allow enough time between the request and the meeting for the program to arrive.

At the time of order, you will be asked to agree, by return email, that neither you nor anyone in your group will copy nor reproduce the program(s). This agreement will be kept in TCI's files.

Rental fee for each program is \$5.00 plus the cost of postage to you. CDs will be sent "First Class" (usually \$2.07) unless Priority Mail is requested. Programs in other formats will be sent "Priority Mail."

SEND NO MONEY at the time of the request. A check made to TCI should be returned with the program. In case of a cancellation or problem, please contact me as soon as possible.

When ordering, state method of viewing you plan to utilize. CDs can be viewed via multi-media projector, on personal computer, or on newer TVs with "S-Video Cable" which is available upon request. DVDs may be viewed with a regular DVD Player and TV. Slides require a slide projector.

GUIDELINES WHEN RECEIVING PROGRAMS –

Mailing instructions, costs and an addressed mailer for return are included with the programs.

GUIDELINES WHEN RETURNING PROGRAMS –

Return the programs immediately following your meeting.

Make one check payable to T.C.I. and enclose with the program.

The rental fee is \$5.00 plus postage to you (see mailer upon arrival). CDs may be returned via “First Class” mail (usually \$2.07). Programs in other formats must be returned via “Priority Mail.”

INTERNATIONAL –

The rental fee is \$5.00 plus the postage to you (see the mailer upon arrival). Return by "AIR MAIL" and attach the required CUSTOMS papers. You may either include a check in US DOLLARS covering postage to you and the \$5.00 fee, OR pay via the TCI Website “Members Only” section. Click on “To Make A Remittance.” Under “Add Special Instructions to Seller,” please state “PROGRAM RENTAL.”
